Organic waste is a valuable raw material.

Which is why it's important to separate it by type!



All compostable waste from your kitchen and garden belongs in the organic waste bin, such as:

- Fruit and vegetable waste
- Coffee filters, teabags, egg shells
- Leftover food (even if it's spoiled), as well as bones from meat and fish
- Grass cuttings, leaves
 - Tree and bush cuttings
 - Withered flowers and potted plants (without decorations or pots!)
 - Newspaper and kitchen paper used to wrap kitchen waste

The following does **NOT** belong in the organic waste bin:

- Packaging made from plastic, glass or metal
- X Nappies or other toiletries
- X Cat and small animal litter, dog waste
- X Vacuum cleaner bags, street sweepings
- X Paper (unless it's been used to wrap organic waste)
- Treated wood or other bulky waste such as cleaning cloths, towels.
- × Textiles
- Ash and other residual waste
